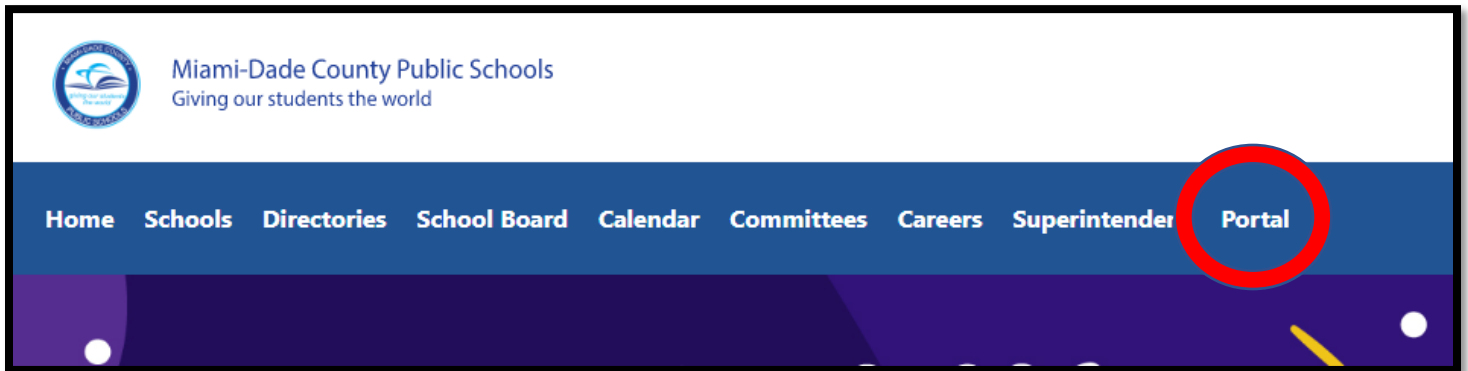


How to access Schoology

1. www.dadeschools.net → Click Portal



2. Sign into the student's portal – This is a sample, not a real student.



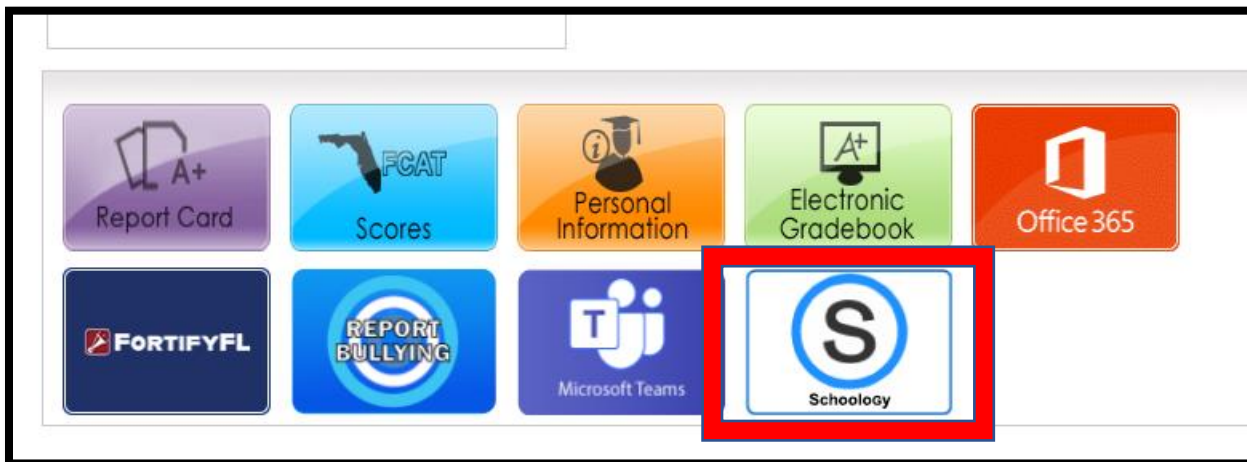

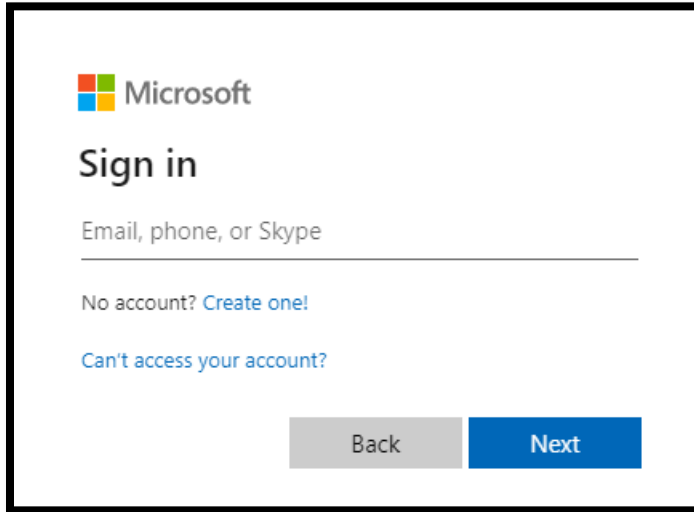


3. Click on the Schoology Tile

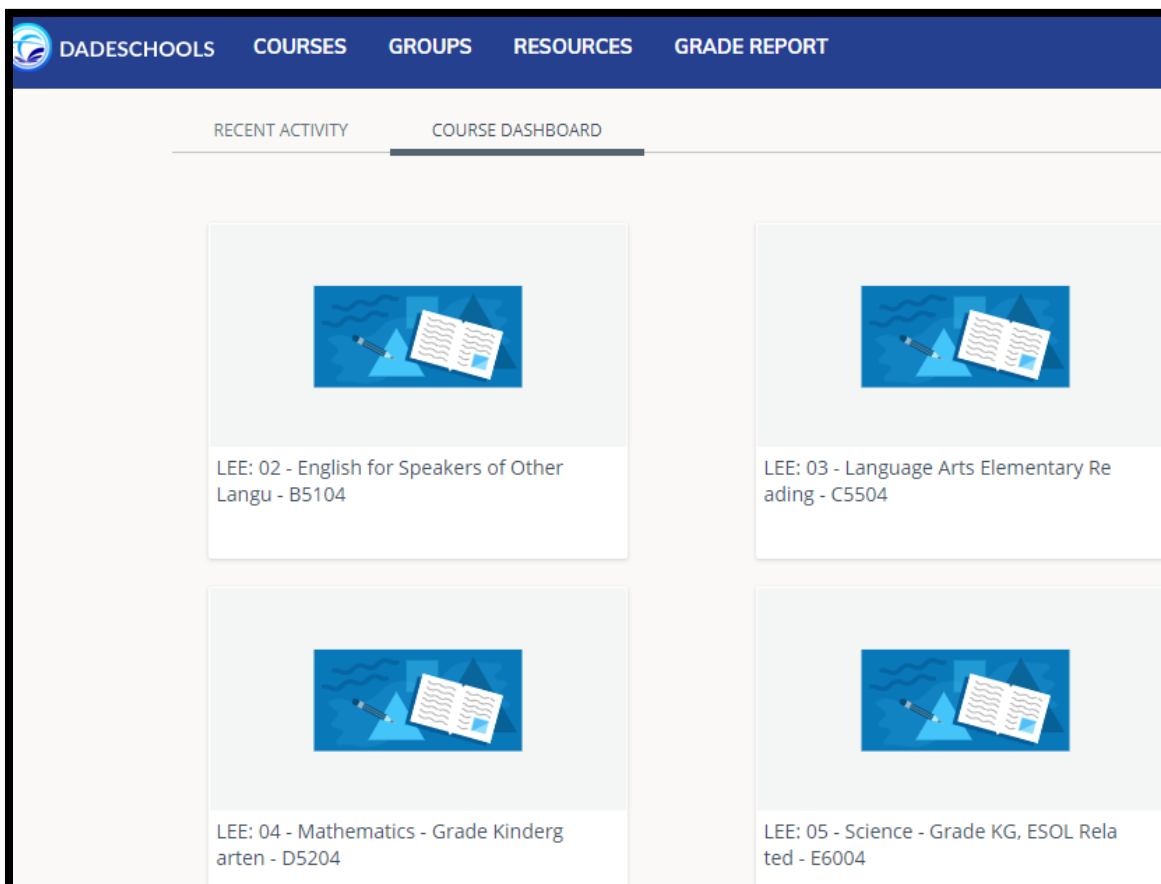
- You can view and monitor your child's grades by clicking on the Electronic Gradebook tile (green).



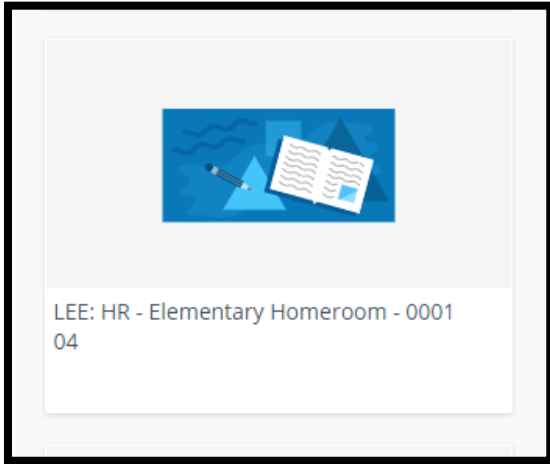
4. Sign in with Microsoft: Email = students ID number@students.dadeschools.net & password is same as the student's portal password



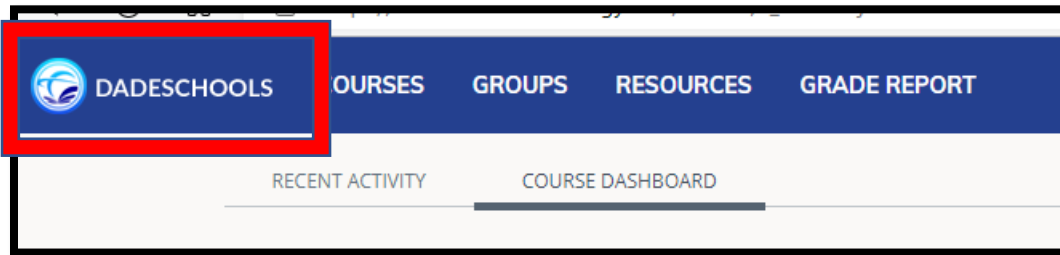
5. You will be directed to "Course Dashboard" page. Under each course, teachers can share activities, links to web pages, and presentations.



6. Find the correct tile for your child's subject. Example- Language Arts Writing or Reading, Math, or Science.

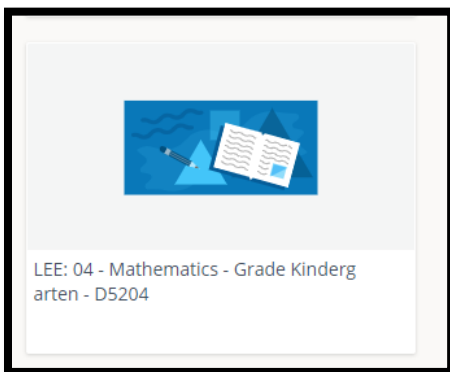

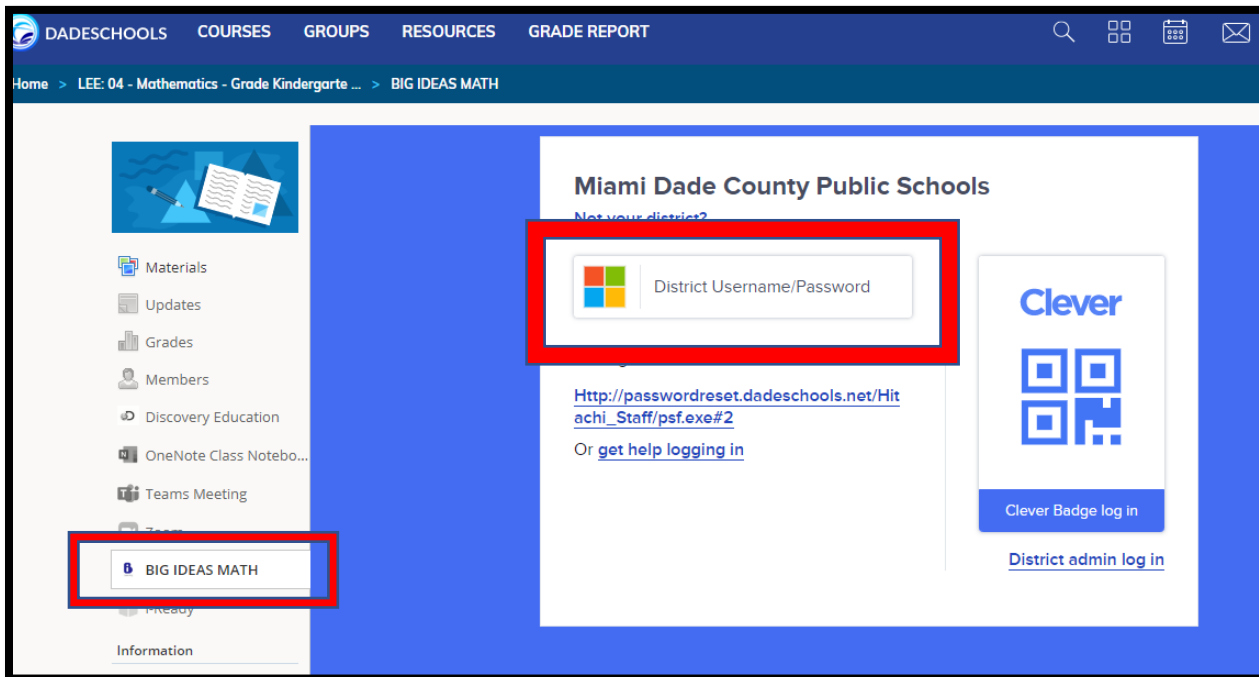


How to access online the Textbooks,

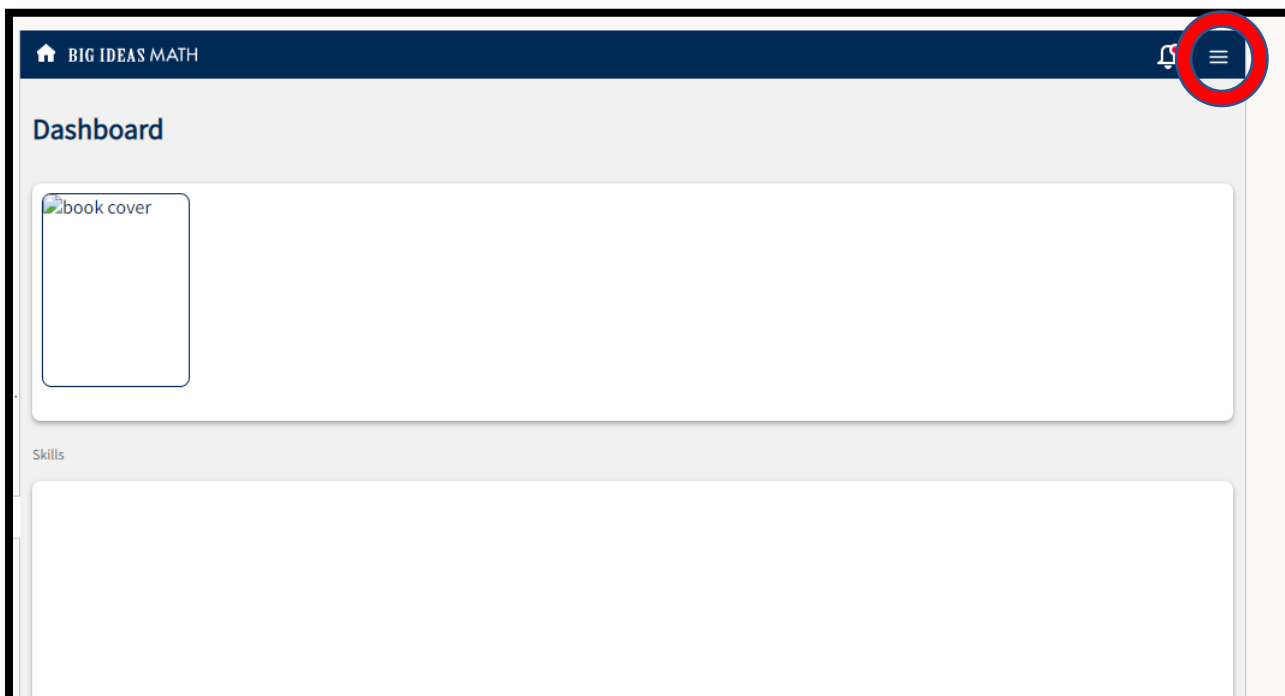
1. Click on the Mathematics, Reading, Science, Social Studies tile.

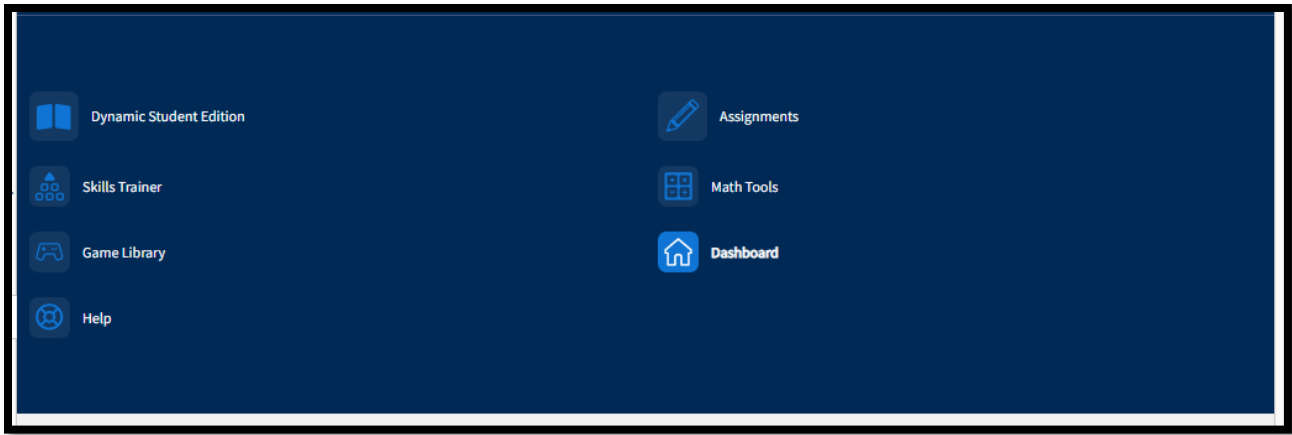


2. The class textbook will appear on the left side towards the bottom.
3. For Math- Click on the “Big IDEAS MATH” → Click on the “District Username/Password”

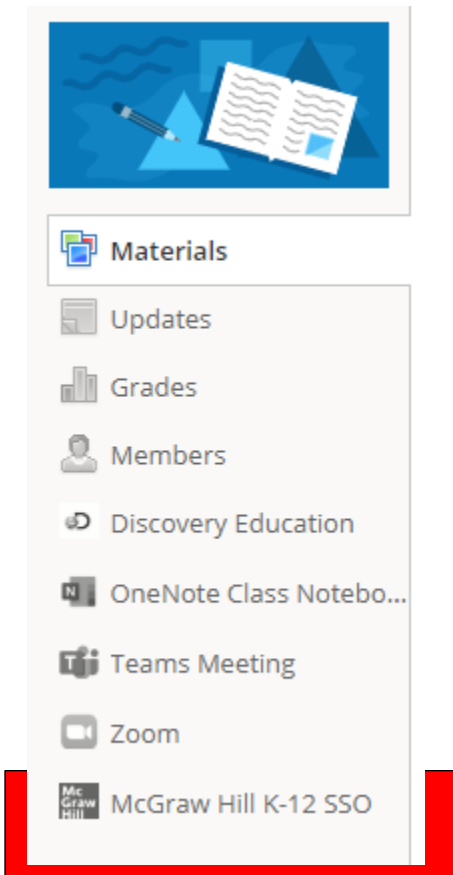


4. You will be directed to the Dashboard. Click on the right top corner to navigate more resources.

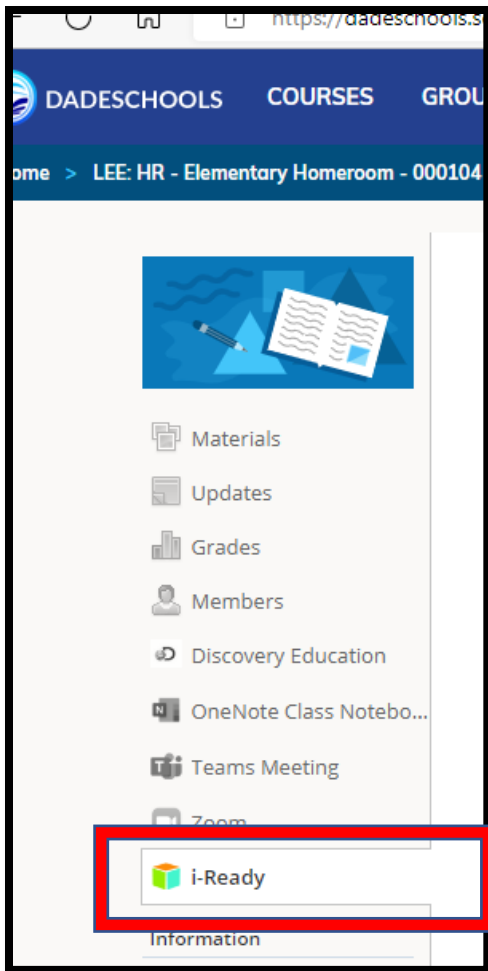

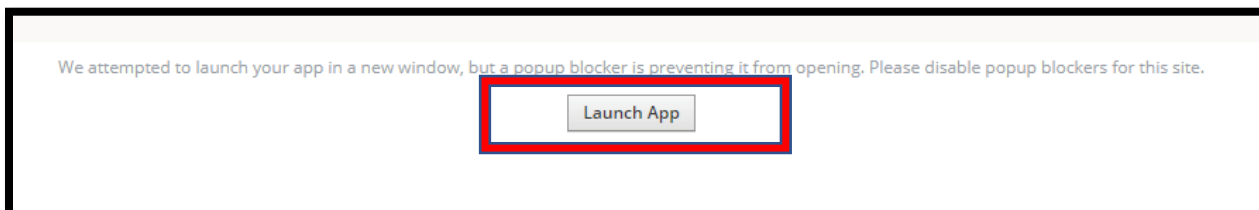
How to access the i-Ready –

- You can go to Writing, Reading, or Math tile to access the i-Ready

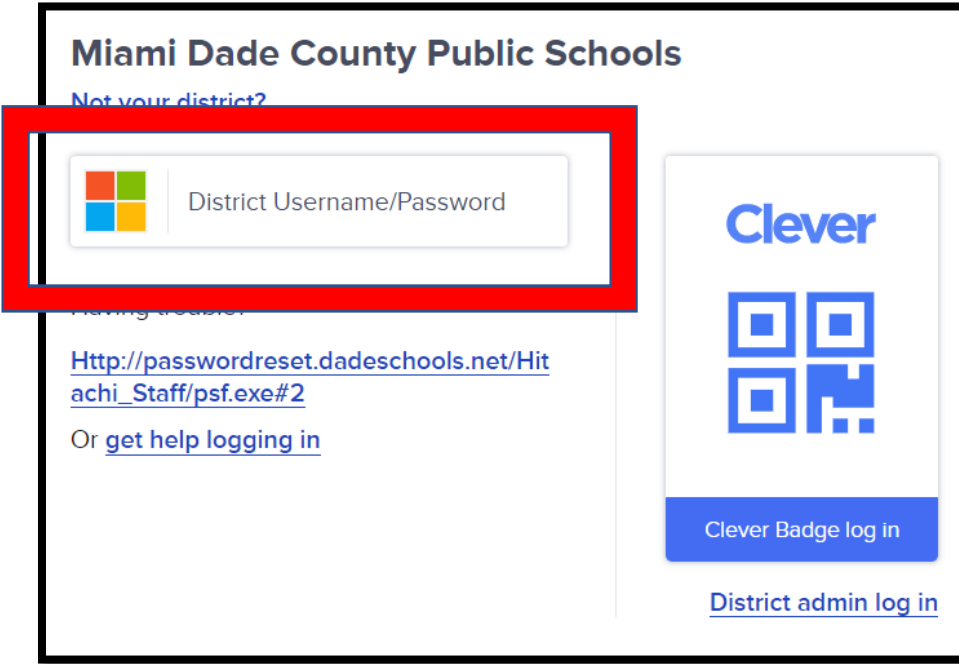
1. Click “i-Ready”
